What a Virtual Networking Support (VNS) Grant is? This is a new COST tool focuses on achieve foster collaboration in a virtual setting, to exchange knowledge, learn new techniques, or disseminate Action results. This grant allows to commission specific work related to assist in the selection of hosts for the virtual networking events and collaboration activities, preparation and coordination of online events and collaboration in virtual activities. Besides, the applicant could have the role of assist in VM Grants. These activities are directly related to the work plan and purpose of ERNST.

How many Grants are available? Only 1 with a maximum amount of 4,000 €. Details of each Grant are available on the ERNST website (<https://cost-ernst.eu>).

What are the work period for these grants? Until to 31/10/2021

What a COST Action is? A network dedicated to scientific collaboration, complementing national research funds. COST supports the networking of researchers through science and technology networks. COST Actions are open to all fields, partners, career stages, and countries.

What the ERNST Consortium is? A COST Action for the study of the second victim phenomenon which involves 29 European countries, 2 neighbor countries, 8 Latin American countries, USA and Japan. The overall aim of this Action is to facilitate discussion and share scientific knowledge, perspectives, and best practices concerning adverse events in healthcare institutions to implement joint efforts to support second victims, and to introduce an open dialogue and discussion among stakeholders about the consequences of the second victim phenomenon based on a cross-national collaboration that integrates different disciplines and approaches

Who can apply? Younger researchers (predoc or postdoc, less than 40 years old) living in the European Countries participating in ERNST Consortium with a primary affiliation to an institution located in these countries. All discipline and field are welcome.

When and how do you can apply? From June, 2nd till June,25th You must send a covering letter and at least a recommendation letter joint the template. This template is available on the website. You can just only apply to one Grant.
